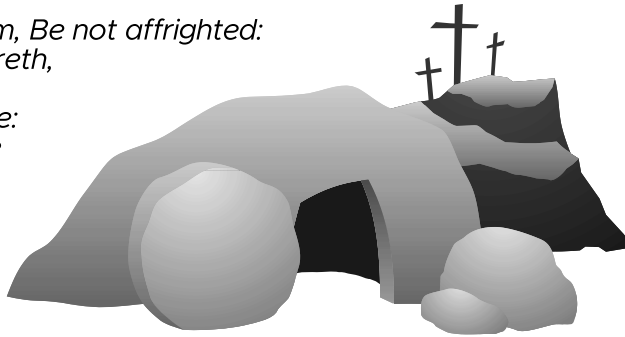


# THE GOSPEL

**Definition:** “A Good Message” of the grace of God

*“And he saith unto them, Be not affrighted:  
Ye seek Jesus of Nazareth,  
which was crucified:  
he is risen; he is not here:  
behold the place where  
they laid him.”*

**Mark 16:6**



## The Good Message

All have sinned, which separates us from a Holy God, and the penalty for sin is death and judgment.

There is no remission of sins without the shedding of blood. Christ shed His blood for all our sins {Past, Present and Future}, was buried and rose again on the third day according to the scriptures. By dying for our sins, He gave His life as an atoning sacrifice and delivered us from the wrath to come. As death and judgment is a result of sin and Jesus lived a sinless life, death could not hold Him. By confessing and believing in His resurrection, we understand the debt for sin has been paid (we are reconciled back to God because we have been justified by His blood).

Now it is only by God's grace through our faith in Christ alone that we are saved. Not of ourselves, not of works lest any man should boast. It is the free gift of God - It is by grace {something we did not earn or deserve} that God gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever shall believe in Him will not perish, but have everlasting life. If you admit that you are a sinner and are in need of God's forgiveness - **the moment you put your faith and trust in the Lord Jesus Christ as your saviour, you will be saved.**

The Holy Spirit will indwell you, lead and guide you, saved and sealed until the day of redemption.

**Accept** that you are guilty of sin and need God's forgiveness

**Romans 3:10** *“As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one”*  
**Romans 3:23** *“For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God”*

**Believe** for salvation that Jesus died to pay for your sins

**Romans 5:8** *“But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.”*  
**John 3:16** *“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.”*  
**Romans 6:23** *“For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.”*

**Call** upon the name of the Lord

**Romans 10:9-13** *“That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him. For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.”*  
**Ephesians 2:8-9** *“For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.”*

**What** should I pray?

*Dear Heavenly Father, Thank you for creating me. I know that I have sinned against you and the penalty for sin is death, judgment and hell. Please forgive me and save me. I believe Jesus died on the cross at Calvary and through His blood paid the penalty for my sins, was buried and rose again. I repent and accept Jesus Christ as my personal Lord and saviour. I put my faith and trust in Him to give me eternal life. Thank you Father for your merciful grace, in Jesus name I pray. Amen.*
